2017 SEWER CONNECTION FEE SCHEDULE

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 13, 2017

The sewer connection fee is as follows:

\$1,899.00 per Equivalent Domestic Unit (EDU)

DEFINITIONS OF EQUIVALENT DOMESTIC UNIT (EDU)

I. Residential Uses

Each apartment, townhouse, single-family dwelling, or similar type of housing unit, shall be assigned 1.0 EDU.

II. Other Uses

Each other use shall be assigned a minimum of 1.0 EDU. An additional 0.33 EDU shall be assigned for each 100 gallons daily, or fraction thereof, in excess of 100 gallons daily, based on flow estimates made in accordance with provisions of the New Jersey Administrative Codes more specifically N.J.A.C. 7:14A-23.3 (Projected Flow Criteria) as supplemented therein on March 20, 2006, and approved by the Executive Director of the Authority.

The Commissioners of the South Monmouth Regional Sewerage Authority established the 2017 Sewer Connection Fee at their meeting on January 12, 2017, pursuant to R.S. 40:14A-18 Amendment to the Schedule of Charges as set forth below. The Resolution amending the Connection Fee is available for public inspection at the SMRSA Administration Office at 1235 18th Avenue, Belmar, New Jersey.

AMENDMENT TO THE SEWER CONNECTION FEE

Effective January 13, 2017, the Sewer Connection Fee shall be \$1,899.00 per Equivalent Domestic Unit (EDU).
