**WHEREAS**, the South Monmouth Regional Sewerage Authority (SMRSA) has determined the need to replace two variable frequency drives (VFDs) at its Glimmer Glass Pump Station in order to maintain the integrity of the asset and enhance its future performance; and

**WHEREAS**, SMRSA's staff and engineer prepared plans and specifications to facilitate said drives to include but not limited to two (2) Yaskawa Matrix UI000 Variable Frequency Drives and recommends this action is necessary for maintaining operations of the Pump Station; and

**WHEREAS**, SMRSA staff and engineer recommends awarding a contract to Willier Electric Motor Repair Company of Gibbsboro, New Jersey for the purchase of two (2) VFDs in the amount of \$28,434.00, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part thereof; and



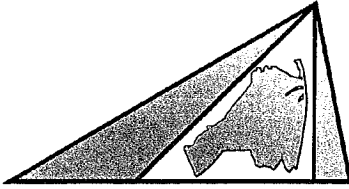

**WHEREAS**, the South Monmouth Regional Sewerage Authority (SMRSA) has determined the need to replace the dry pit submersible pump at its Wall North Pump Station in order to maintain the integrity of the asset and enhance its future performance; and

**WHEREAS**, SMRSA's staff and engineer prepared plans and specifications to facilitate said pump to include but not limited to one (1) Sulzer/ABS PE200/6 Dry Pit Submersible Pump and recommends this action is necessary for maintaining operations of the Pump Station; and

**WHEREAS**, SMRSA staff and engineer recommends awarding a contract to Reiner Pump Systems Inc. of Stanhope, New Jersey for the purchase of one (1) Sulzer/ABS PE200/6 Dry Pit Submersible Pump and related ancillary parts including but not limited to one (1) seal fail/thermal overload relay in the amount of \$25,087.00, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part thereof; and



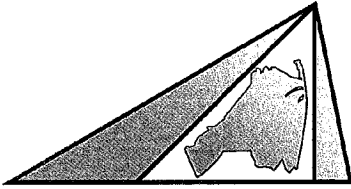
